

General (Needs Based) Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- A. To be considered for a scholarship, the following are the eligibility requirements:
 - 1. The student must demonstrate sound academic performance or progress.
 - 2. The student must demonstrate financial need or hardship. Proof of financial need can be satisfied by one of the following:
 - a. Identified by School Guidance Counsellor Department as a student from a family with financial hardship.
 - b. A letter of reference from a respected community member aware of the student's financial hardship. (E.g., Church pastor, Coach, etc.)
 - 3. The student must have a co-curricular activity such as being in a club/society or participating in a sporting activity.
 - 4. The parent(s) or guardian of the student must consent and sign the application.
- B. To remain on a scholarship, the following requirements shall be met:
 - 1. The student must maintain strong academic performance or progress.
 - 2. The student must keep a 95% attendance record.
 - 3. The student must be free of any disciplinary issues.
 - 4. The student must be participating in school co-curricular life by being in a school sanctioned club or be a member of a school sports team.
 - 5. The student must send a letter to the scholarship committee to update his grades and school activities at the end of every school term.
